

Mystery Block for Richmond and Kew Quilters April + June 2022

Covered Corners / Pecking Order

Precut the required number of 6" squares



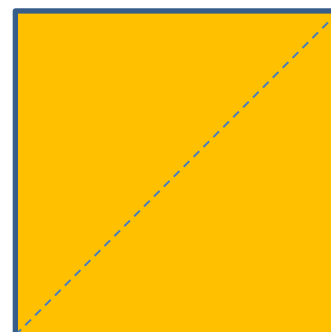
The same number of 3.5" squares in bright colours – either all different (ie like the jewel corners below left, or all the same contrasting with the large squares like the example bottom right)

Patterned fabric is fine but please use fabrics that overall read as one colour

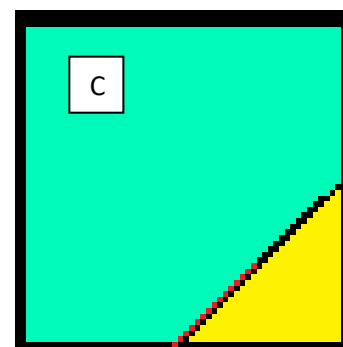
On each 3.5" square please mark a diagonal corner-to-corner line like image (A)

Pin each 3.5" square accurately in one corner of each 6" square (RST)

and stitch along the marked lines like image (B).



Trim away the excess triangles, and press open, leaving 6 inch squares that look like image (C)



When they are all completed, you can speed-date the blocks until you are happy with the arrangement. They will make a sort of circle shape (in lines or offset), or I'm sure you can find other great ideas
